Master Plan for YSS Chennai Ashram

Creating a Spiritual Sanctuary in South India

In September 2024, Swami Chidanandaji, our revered president, formally announced that the YSS Chennai Retreat would be developed into a full-fledged YSS ashram. Since then, the increased number of spiritual programmes offered there, along with a large participation of devotees has further confirmed the need for a spiritual sanctuary in South India — an ashram that will draw many truth-seekers, today and in the future to God-communion, fellowship, and divine inspiration.

To make this sacred vision a reality, a **comprehensive Master Plan** has been developed, using the expertise of accomplished architects and engineers. Our goal is to build a serene, verdant, beautifully landscaped campus where devotees can come to immerse themselves in deep meditation, study, and contemplation on Gurudeva's teachings — all while remaining in the lap of Mother Nature.

During his visit this year in February, Swami Chidanandaji personally toured the Chennai ashram, reviewed the Master Plan, and blessed this project.

Project Overview

Foundational Works (₹10 crore)

Land levelling, perimeter roads, walkways, storm water drains, and utility



Phase I: Meditation & Accommodation Facilities (₹55 crore)

- A meditation hall for 1,200 devotees
- Accommodation for 100 devotees and 25 monks
- Kitchen and dining hall
- Children's Satsanga facilities
- Administration building
- Publications warehouse

Phase II: Expansion & Sustainability (₹45 crore)

- A smaller Satsanga Hall
- Additional accommodation for guests
- Sevak quarters
- Solar power and other utilities





The total financial requirement for the foundational works and Phase I of the project is ₹65 crore. We warmly welcome your support in bringing this divine vision to fruition.

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A Sacred Gathering at Kumbha Mela

From January 10 to February 15, 2025, Yogoda Satsanga Society of India organized a spiritual camp at the Kumbha Mela in Prayagraj. Over 2,500 YSS/SRF devotees from India and abroad visited and stayed at this camp during this period, enjoying divine fellowship in the sacred environs of the mela.

YSS sannyasis conducted daily meditations, kirtans, and satsangas, creating a small spiritual sanctuary for the devotees amidst the jubilant atmosphere of the mela. The camp offered a unique opportunity to devotees of Gurudeva's worldwide spiritual family to practise Gurudeva's sadhana in the setting of the Kumbha Mela. YSS ran a charitable medical clinic at the camp site where volunteer doctors attended to thousands of pilgrims and gave them free medicines. Many truth-seekers visited the YSS bookstall and found inspiration and solace through Guruji's writings.

This year, Sadhana Sangams held at YSS ashrams in Ranchi, Noida, Dakshineswar, Chennai, and the Paramahansa Yogananda Sadhanalaya at Igatpuri were attended by nearly 4,000 devotees from India and abroad — treasured occasions of spiritual renewal and deeper communion with God and Guru.









Monastic Tours

Sharing Yoganandaji's timeless wisdom more widely, YSS *sannyasis* toured more than 50 cities, conducting programmes that helped devotees apply Gurudeva's teachings in their daily lives. At many locations, public lectures introduced new seekers to the science of yoga meditation. Kriya Yoga initiations, for eligible students of the *YSS Lessons*, marked the happy culmination of some of these tours.

SRF Convocation Streamed at YSS Ashrams for the First Time

For the first time, YSS ashrams across India hosted devotees for screenings of the SRF World Convocation (June 23–29, 2025), allowing nearly 350 devotees to join in this sacred global gathering while immersed in the uplifting atmosphere of an ashram. Devotees immersed themselves in Gurudeva's timeless wisdom conveyed through inspiring talks and classes by SRF monastics which were streamed during the day. The highlights of the event were live-streaming of a three-hour meditation led by revered Swami Chidanandaji, and his *satsanga*.

Inauguration of New Dhyana Mandir

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Tuni

We are delighted to share that the devotees of Yogoda Satsanga Dhyana Kendra — Tuni (located in Kakinada district of Andhra Pradesh), with tireless dedication and heartfelt enthusiasm, have completed the construction of a beautiful new Dhyana Mandir. The Dhyana Mandir was inaugurated on July 25 this year, and was followed by a two-day spiritual programme led by YSS

sannyasis, Swamis Smaranananda and Kedarananda, which included satsangas, group meditations, and the sacred Kriya Yoga diksha ceremony. The blessed occasion was attended by over 200 devotees.





Thiruvannamalai

A new Dhyana Mandali and bookstore was inaugurated in April in Thiruvannamalai, Tamil Nadu, by Swami Suddhananda. Situated along the sacred

pilgrimage route around Arunachala Mountain—traversed by nearly one lakh pilgrims each full moon—this meditation centre holds great promise as a channel for outreach for Guruji's spiritual teachings. Through *satsangas*, meditations, and the YSS publications, countless seekers who come here for pilgrimage will now have the opportunity to discover the soul-liberating teachings of our beloved Guru.



Online Dhyana Kendra — New Initiatives

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To better serve devotees across India, the Online Dhyana Kendra has introduced devotee-led meditations in Malayalam, along with the existing meditations in English, Hindi, Bengali, Kannada, Tamil, and Telugu. Further, a new Lesson Study group



on the Supplement Lessons is now being offered every Monday evening, alongside the ongoing Basic Lessons study group on Fridays.

These initiatives are helping to bring Gurudeva's teachings into the homes of many devotees who may not live near a YSS meditation centre — bringing them the blessings of group meditation and spiritual study.

International Day of Yoga

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International Day of Yoga Programmes

On the occasion of the International Day of Yoga on June 21, YSS organized both online and in-person events to promote the practice of Kriya Yoga for the well-being of body, mind, and soul. YSS *sannyasis* conducted introductory sessions on yoga and meditation in English and various Indian languages.



The online sessions gathered more than 70,000 views and thousands attended the in-person programmes at our ashrams and kendras.

This year, book fairs were organized in 40 cities across India, including New Delhi, Kolkata, Hyderabad, Chennai, Pune, and Ahmedabad. These events provided seekers from all walks of life the opportunity to be introduced to the writings of Sri Sri Paramahansa Yogananda.

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Summer Camps for Children at Ranchi, Noida, and Chennai

Guided by experienced devotee-teachers, the children took part in a series of "how-to-live" classes to learn about concentration, character development, will power, and introspection. Their daily schedule included group meditations, Energization Exercises, *yogasanas*, and creative activities such as drawing and crafts. More than 300 children participated in the various camps, receiving a foundation in spiritual living that could serve as a guiding light throughout their lives.

Material, Medical, and Educational Aid to the Needy

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Uttarakhand Relief Work

In response to the cloudbursts, floods, and landslides in Uttarakhand, Yogoda Satsanga Society of India extended monetary assistance to the state government. In September, YSS sannyasis, Swami



Ishwarananda and Swami Dhairyananda, met Uttarakhand Chief Minister, Shri Pushkar Singh Dhami, in Dehradun and presented a cheque of ₹25 lakh towards the Chief Minister's Relief Fund to support ongoing relief operations.

YSS Charitable Dispensary Inaugurated Near Chennai Ashram

A charitable dispensary, located just 1.5 km from the YSS Chennai ashram,

was inaugurated in June this year. Supported by 11 devotee-doctors, it has been serving the local underprivileged community. Open five days a week, it offers free consultation and medicines, and has already provided medical care to over a thousand patients.







Medical Camps Organized by Dwarahat Ashram

A three-day free medical camp was held in April 2025 at the Yogoda Satsanga Sakha Ashram, Dwarahat. Along with the main camp at the ashram, smaller camps were organized in the remote villages of Suraikhet and Kholiyabaj,



bringing much-needed healthcare to underserved communities. In all, more than 2,000 people from the Dwarahat region benefited from the humanitarian service extended during that period.

The camp was made possible through the loving efforts of a dedicated team of around 20 specialist doctors and 5 paramedics who came from across India to serve. The next medical camp is planned for November 2025.





Yearly Scholarships

YSS continues to serve deserving and meritorious students from less fortunate backgrounds by providing scholarships. Last year, scholarships amount-

ing to ₹75 lakh were disbursed.

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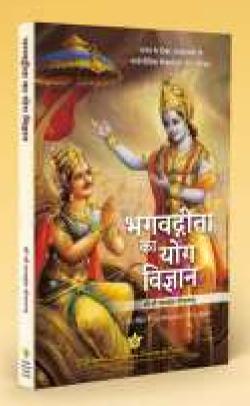

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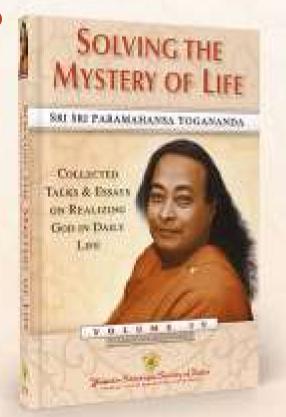
